On Saturday 12/18 at 9 am volunteers are needed to assist Sacred Heart Church and Heart of Camden Housing Corporation in distributing over 1,000 food baskets for the poor. After a prayer of Thanksgiving and a song or two the volunteers are given a map, load up their cars and set off on what can only be described as a bizarre scavenger hunt to deliver all the makings of a holiday feast in some of the most poorly marked blocks and houses in Camden.

Sacred Heart Church is located at Broadway and Ferry Avenues (in the basement but they may send you upstairs to the church first). Come early and park as close as you can since a peach basket full of food and a frozen turkey or chicken can get surprisingly heavy. We recommend that each car or truck should have 2 or 3 people in it since someone should stay with the car while others navigate and deliver. If it is only yourself, not a problem just see me or the guy with the microphone and we can find you someone to pair you up with. I can usually be found distributing the maps.

It usually takes until about noon to deliver the baskets. Just be forewarned.... You might have fun and feel good about yourself afterwards.
