

Whistler-Blackcomb, British Columbia

Fall Line Ski Club returns to one of its favorite destinations, Whistler-Blackcomb in British Columbia, from February 5–12, 2011. The last time Fall Line has been here was back in 2002. We are long overdue to return, and a lot has changed. While hosting Olympic ski events earlier this year, Whistler-Blackcomb has made many improvements to the area. Join us for what is sure to be a memorable ski trip.

Those who have been to Whistler-Blackcomb know all about the 8,100 skiable acres including two mountains, three glaciers, over 5,000 vertical feet, over 200 trails, 38 lifts, 17 mountain restaurants and the over 400 inches of snow the area receives.

If you have not yet been to Whistler-Blackcomb, this is a great opportunity to get to know one of the premier ski areas in North America (and therefore, the world too). This is one really huge ski area, with enough variety to be enjoyable to skiers and snowboarders of all abilities. Find out why this is one of the favorite ski area of so many skiers.

The two mountains are now connected by the Peak 2 Peak Gondola, which opened in December, 2008, and is one of the longest and highest gondolas in the world. A quick eleven minute ride will take you from one mountain to the other.

We will be flying through Chicago to Vancouver, BC and traveling by bus for two hours to Whistler-Blackcomb. We will be staying in Whistler Village at the Hotel Listel, conveniently located a mere one hundred yards from the ski lifts. The hotels offer double occupancy rooms, hot tub and sauna, high speed internet access, and ski storage. Room occupancies for three or four people will be available for a discounted price if requested.

The trip opens for sign-up on July 20. The price of the trip is \$1,669 per person for early sign-up, and \$1,719 after August 3. The trip includes:

- Round trip airfare from Philadelphia to Vancouver
- Bus transportation to Whistler Village
- 7 night accommodations at the Hotel Listel, double occupancy
- 6 day ski lift ticket
- Personal Luggage tags

For triple occupancy rooms, the trip price will be reduced by \$125 per person. For quad occupancy rooms, the trip price will be reduced by \$185 per person. So, assemble a group of friends and receive a nice discount.
