Aspen Mountain is famous for its black-diamond terrain. While there is no easy terrain here, there are plenty of intermediate trails to enjoy. Inbounds, you'll find a variety of glades, bumps and steeps. Aspen Mountain Powder Tours can hook you up with fresh tracks on an out-of-bounds experience on the backside of the mountain.

Aspen Highlands offers breathtaking 360-degree views of the Maroon Bells and an abundance of expert terrain as well as groomed cruisers. It is no wonder Aspen Highlands has been the locals' favorite for over 50 years.

Buttermilk, with its wide-open and gently rolling trails, is a favorite for beginners and families. It is also famous for hosting the ESPN Winter X Games through 2012 and being voted #1 by Transworld Snowboarding Magazine Reader's Poll for best park and pipe.

During the evenings or a day off from skiing, you can take a shuttle to enjoy exploring the town of Aspen, with its wide variety of shopping, restaurants and nightlife.
