## Hakuba Ski Valley area details:

- 10 ski resorts on one ski pass
- Highest elevation: Hakuba-one at 6007 feet
- Biggest Vertical: Hakuba-one at 3,514 feet
- 149 trails. Longest run 8km
- 10 to 11 meters average snowfall (32 to 36 feet!!)
- Degree of difficulty percentages for trails: Beginner 30% / Intermediate 40% / Advanced 30%
- Night Skiing is available at four of the resorts in Hakuba

## ITINERARY

- Arrive Friday Jan. 7 and check into the **Hilton Tokyo Narita Airport Hotel** for one night (breakfast included) to decompress and rest before departing for Hakuba the next morning by private luxury tour bus. Ski equipment can be sent forward from the Hilton Hotel upon arrival.
- Stay at the **Hakuba Tokyu Hotel** for 7 nights and 6 days skiing. There will be an option for midweek day tours of the region (details TBD). Meals included: Breakfast daily and Dinner for 3 nights of your choosing. This allows one to explore the extensive dining scene in Hakuba for the other 4 nights.
- Return to Tokyo by tour bus on Saturday Feb 4 and stay at the **Shiba Park Hotel** for 5 nights to tour and see the fabulous city of Tokyo. Breakfast included for entire stay.
- Depart Tokyo on Thursday Feb 9 and arrive Newark the same day.
