## FEBRUARY PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

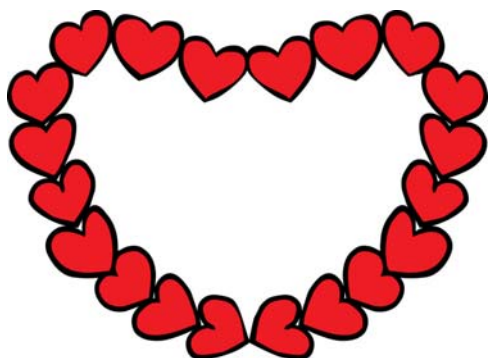
Hello everyone!

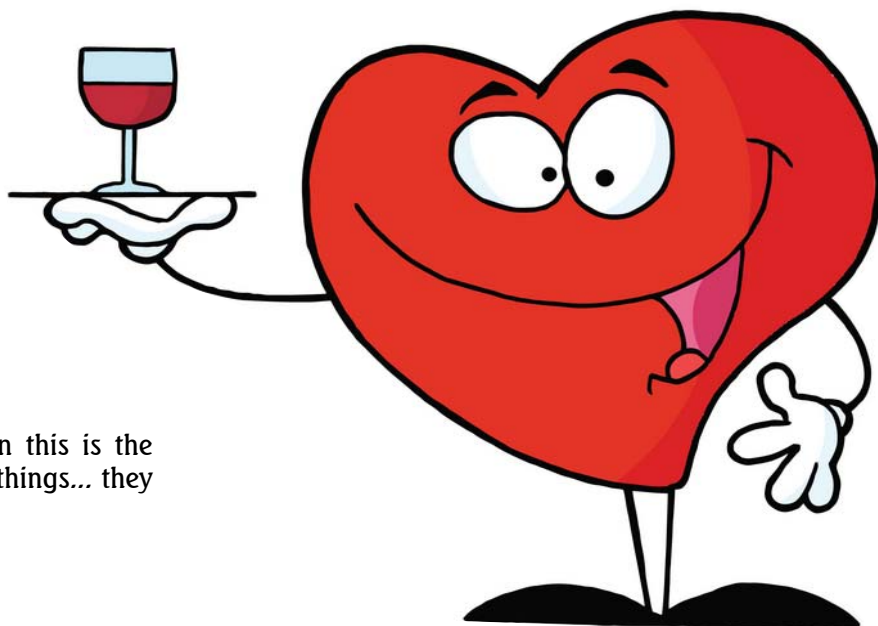
