## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE


Warm Greetings To All,

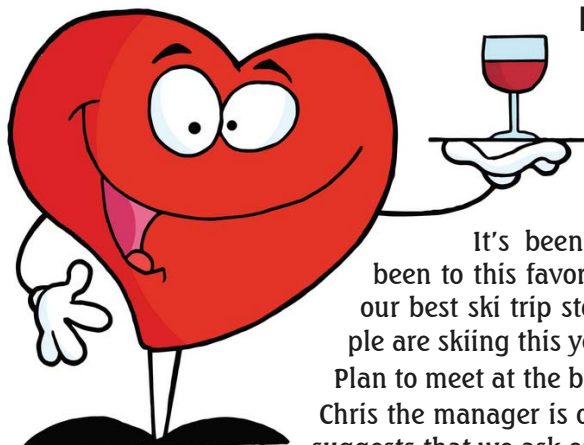
