*Fishtown, 1210 Frankford Avenue.* Located in the heart of Fishtown, Frankford Hall is probably the most authentic-feeling beer garden in town, with indoor and outdoor seating for more than 400, multiple bars, an abundance of picnic tables, and games ranging from Jenga to ping pong. Effectively, the space is usable year-round with the help of more than a dozen heat lamps, a couple fire pits and an overhead heating system. Classic German foods (think pretzels, bratwurst) plus burgers are available at a walk-up counter, as is a hefty beer menu that includes everything from traditional German beers to craft specialties.
