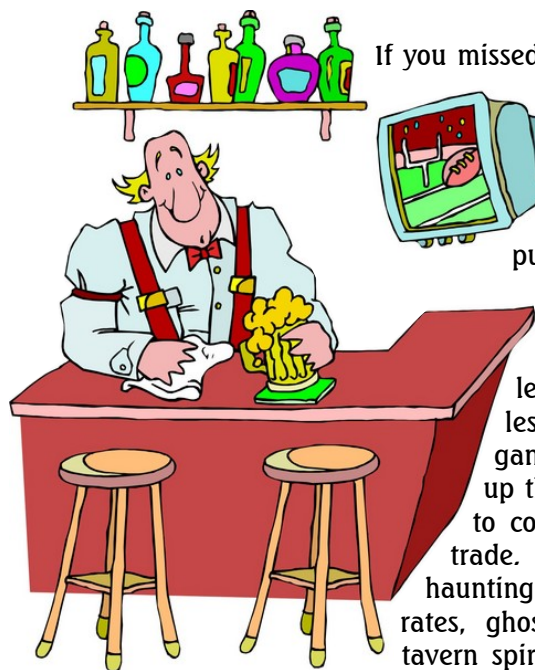
The tour is being planned for around 1 or 1:30 then we'll move to Iron Hill Brewery in Voorhees for a late lunch or early happy hour.
